

I have read non-fiction my whole life almost exclusively, because well researched truth is so much more fascinating than any fabricated tale. I read the condensed version of this book in Reader's Digest more than 40 years ago and had the incredible pleasure of reading the real book later; it forever will remain the most spell binding nonfiction work I have ever read!

Two American medical teams fully researched and documented Arigo's out-of-this-world skills as a surgeon [with hardly any education to his credit]; they were simply baffled and could not explain the phenomenon. How could they? It could only be explained through Arigo's supernatural powers that were given to him by Jesus Christ whom he invokes and prays to, which is also well documented in the book.

Why is that, when the Medical Science establishment hits a brick wall [as in Arigo's case] and cannot explain certain human phenomena, they cannot admit the existence of a supernatural power [or God forbid, a G-O-D]?
